## **How do we join and participate in Summer Reading?**

1. Children ages 2 through those entering 6th grade who are residents of the Ramapo Central School District may register anytime between June 15 and July 31, 2009. You must show your Suffern or Sloatsburg Library card in order to register.
2. Children are encouraged to read books, magazines, etc. and write the titles in their reading log. Children may also write the titles of anything that is read to them in their reading log.
3. Children should come in once a week, beginning June 29th, and show their reading logs to the librarians or teen volunteers in the children's room.
4. Children will receive stickers for each book or for every 50 pages they read. Each week, new prizes will be given out to our readers.
5. Look inside for all the other special events that will be held throughout the summer.
