Guidelines and Procedures

- 1. Drawings, paintings and photographs will displayed on one of two bulletin boards, 4 x 6', located to the right of the door to the Children's Room. Exhibits will be tacked or stapled to the board. We will provide thumb tacks or staples but no other materials. No tape or labels are permitted on the walls. All work must fit in the assigned area.
- 2. Subject of the art works must be appropriate to the Children's Room.
- 3. Child should fill out and hand in an "Artist of the Month Application". The child must live in the Ramapo Central School District, and must be in Grades K 6. A group of children many choose to display their art together. Artists may repeat every 3rd year.
- 4. Neither the library nor the Library Board accepts responsibility for loss or damage of displayed items.
- 5. Exhibits are shown for one month. Artwork will be removed on the assigned day to avoid interference with the next exhibit. All art must be picked up after the exhibit is over. Library will not hold art after one month from the date of exhibit end.
