

Suffern Free Library - Children's Room Use

Approved by Suffern Free Library Board of Trustees on May 24, 2022

This policy supersedes all prior policies and practices relative to this subject.

The Children's room of the Suffern Free Library is hereby dedicated to the exclusive use of library patrons who fall within the following categories:

1. Patrons of the library who are in 6th grade or younger.
2. Patrons of the library who are in 7th – 12th grade and/or adults who are accompanying a child in 6th grade or younger.
3. Adults and students in 7th – 12th grade who are using materials located only in the Children's Room: i.e. Game computers or browsing for books to select.

It is the further practice and procedure of the Suffern Free Library that any individual who does not fall within the above designated categories will be requested and required to move to a different part of the library. It is also the practice and procedure of the Suffern Free Library to ask patrons in 7th – 12th grade and adults to move to another area of the library once materials have been chosen.
