NYS Empire Pass


- Pass permits unlimited FREE vehicle access to most facilities operated by the NYS Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation, and the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation.
- Pass DOES NOT guarantee parking when the park is at maximum capacity. Parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis and does not allow for early entry prior to park hours.
- Pass DOES NOT guarantee free vehicle entry into the park during special events.
- Pass DOES NOT include waiver of fees for camping, golf, museum or historic site admission. Other special activity fees are not included.

Borrowing a Pass

- ⇒ Passes may *only* be borrowed by adult residents of the Suffern Central School District who have a valid library card.
- ⇒ Individual passes may be borrowed one at a time and once per month per family.
- ⇒ Passes may be reserved for 24 hours if available. Please call 845-357-1237 or stop by the Checkout Desk for more information or to inquire.
- ⇒ Passes *must* be checked out at and returned to the Suffern Free Library Checkout Desk.
- ⇒ Passes may be borrowed for 5 days with no renewals.
- ⇒ There is a \$10/day overdue charge and a \$100 replacement cost per pass.
- ⇒ Please visit the museum Website *before* your visit for hours, COVID restrictions, occupancy limitations, directions, and other admission information.
