Suffern Free Library cardholders who are physically unable to travel to the library can receive library books at their homes. Suffern Library's **Homebound Books-by-Mail** service is available to cardholders who cannot reach the library due to illness, age or disability.

To register, qualified cardholders need only fill out the attached form and mail it to the library. It's that easy!

Requested books will arrive at the cardholder's home by U.S. Mail in a special book mailing bag. The books must be returned by mail. Place them in the special book mailing bag and turn over the postage paid mailing label so that the library address is showing.

The materials may be kept for 28 days. When the materials are returned, new materials will be sent.
